CHAPTER 72

AN ACT authorizing the regents of the university to sell lands therein described to the United States for the purpose of expanding the U. S. forest products laboratory area, and appropriating the proceeds of the sale to the regents for purchase of land for the expansion of the Madison campus of the university.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

The regents of the university of Wisconsin are authorized to convey to the United States of America for such consideration and upon such terms, conditions and covenants as the regents shall determine, approximately 12 acres of land located north of and adjacent to the present site of the U. S. forest products laboratory, at Madison, to provide an expansion area for said laboratory. The consideration shall be such as the regents deem appropriate in view of the benefits that will accrue to the university. The proceeds from the sale shall be paid into the general fund, and are appropriated therefrom to the regents for the purchase of land for the expansion of the Madison campus of the university, and the regents may pay the expenses of the sale authorized by this act out of said appropriation.
