CHAPTER 261

AN ACT authorizing the board of regents of state colleges to sell state-owned lands therein described, located in the city of La Crosse, and crediting the proceeds to the La Crosse state college dormitory account in the appropriation made by section 20.670 (43) of the statutes, and authorizing said board to expend therefrom amounts for paying the expenses of the sale.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. The secretary of the board of regents of state colleges, with the approval of the governor, is authorized to sell and convey that portion of the state-owned lands, known as the College Co-op House, located at 401 West Avenue South, city of La Crosse, Wisconsin, which are now a part of the premises of the Wisconsin state colleges and described as follows: "The West 160 feet of the North 60 feet of Lot 2, Rublee and Gillette's Addition to the Village of La Crosse, and the South 43 feet of Lot 6 of D. G. McMillan's Subdivision to the City of La Crosse," at such price and on such terms, conditions and covenants as the secretary determines; the proceeds of the sale to be deposited in the general fund and credited to the La Crosse state college dormitory account in the appropriation made by section 20.760 (43) of the statutes, and the board of regents of state colleges is authorized to pay the expenses of the sale out of said appropriation.

SECTION 2. This bill is declared to be an emergency appropriation bill in accordance with section 16.47 (2) of the statutes.
