## CHAPTER 478

AN ACT to amend chapter 3, laws of 1963, special session, sections 3 and 4, relating to the first election of the circuit court judge in the twenty-sixth judicial circuit.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

Chapter 3, laws of 1963, special session, sections 3 and 4 are amended to read:

(Chapter 3, laws of 1963, special session) Section 3. A judge for the twenty-sixth judicial circuit shall be elected in the several election precincts of Walworth county \* \* \* at a special election to be held on June 23, 1964, in accordance with the laws relating to the election of circuit judges.

The period for circulating nomination papers for such post shall commence on April 21, 1964, and nomination papers shall be filed no later than May 21, 1964. If a primary election is necessary, it shall be held in such precincts on May 26, 1964. The term of office of the judge chosen at such election shall commence on \* \* \* October 1, 1964, and expire on the first Monday in January 1971. Thereafter the term shall begin on the first Monday in January.

Section 4. Until \* \* \* October 1, 1964, Walworth county shall, for jurisdictional purposes, continue a part of the first judicial circuit, and until that time the judge of the first judicial circuit shall continue to hold terms of court therein as prior to the effective date of this act.
