CHAPTER 50

AN ACT to create 20.670 (61e) of the statutes, relating to authorizing the state department of public welfare to sell certain land attached to the Wisconsin state reformatory and the disposition of the proceeds from such sale, and making an appropriation.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. 20.670 (61e) of the statutes is created to read:

20.670 (61e) PROCEEDS FROM SALE OF LAND. The net amount of the proceeds received as a result of sale of farm land as specified in chapter 50, laws of 1963 shall be deposited in the general fund and are appropriated therefrom to the state department of public welfare for the purchase, subject to the approval of the state building commission, of other correctional institutions farm land including buildings and for the remodeling or construction of buildings. Such net amounts or any part thereof are not to be a part of the revolving fund under sub. (61).

Section 2. The state department of public welfare, with the approval of the governor, is authorized to sell and convey under such terms, conditions and covenants as the state building commission determines, that portion of reformatory farm land lying in the town of Allouez, Brown County, Wisconsin, in Private Claim 20 E, extending easterly from South Webster Avenue to the East River. First priority to purchase such land at the fair market value may be granted to the Allouez school district.

Section 3. This bill is declared to be an emergency appropriation bill under section 16.47 (2) of the statutes.
