Chapter 565

AN ACT to repeal and recreate 30.71 of the statutes, relating to boat toilets.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. 30.71 of the statutes is repealed and recreated to read:

30.71 BOATS EQUIPPED WITH TOILETS. (1) No persons shall operate any boat equipped with toilets on inland waters of this state, except the Mississippi river, unless the toilet wastes are retained for shore

disposal by means of facilities constructed and operated in accordance with rules adopted by the state board of health. "Inland waters" means the waters defined as inland waters by s. 29.01 (4).

(2) Until October 31, 1967, sub. (1) shall not apply to the St. Croix river below Houlton-Stillwater.

SECTION 2. The Minnesota-Wisconsin boundary area commission created pursuant to the compact between the 2 states ratified by this state by chapter 274, laws of 1965, shall study the problems resulting on the St. Croix river from the conflicting boat toilet requirements under the laws of Minnesota and of this state, and shall submit a report of its findings and recommendations, including suggested legislation if any, to the 1967 legislature when it convenes.
