CHAPTER 126, LAWS OF 1967

AN ACT to amend 140.28 (1) (intro.) of the statutes, relating to the composition of an advisory committee to the state board of health on uniform hospital standards.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

140.28 (1) (intro.) of the statutes is amended to read:

140.28 (1) (intro.) The board shall appoint an advisory committee ~~which shall~~ to consist of the secretary of the board or his duly appointed representative, who shall serve as secretary of the committee at the pleasure of the board, and § 9 other members, 2 of whom shall be persons of recognized ability in the field of hospital administration, one chosen from a list submitted by the Wisconsin hospital association and one chosen from a list submitted by the Wisconsin conference of Catholic hospitals; one shall be a physician of recognized ability, chosen from a list submitted by the Wisconsin state medical society; *one shall be an osteopathic physician and surgeon licensed to practice medicine and surgery of recognized ability chosen from a list submitted by the Wisconsin association of osteopathic physicians and surgeons*; one shall be a person of recognized ability from the field of nursing, chosen from a list submitted by the Wisconsin nurses

association; one shall be a person of recognized ability from the field of dentistry, chosen from a list submitted by the state dental society; one shall be a person of recognized ability from the field of hospital pharmacy, chosen from a list submitted by the state pharmaceutical association; and 2 persons chosen to represent the general public.
