CHAPTER 236, LAWS OF 1967

AN ACT to amend 103.69 (3) (d) and 103.78 (1) (d) of the statutes, relating to the employment of minors at dance halls.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. 103.69 (3) (d) of the statutes is amended to read:

103.69 (3) (d) Dance halls and pavilions. *This prohibition shall not apply to dances held solely for minors conducted by private clubs or civic*

organizations where admission is limited to the membership of the club or by their invitation and the general public is excluded.

SECTION 2. 103.78 (1) (d) of the statutes is amended to read:

103.78 (1) (d) *Except as provided in s. 103.69 (3),* the employment or appearance shall at no time be in a roadhouse, cabaret, dance hall, night club, tavern or other similar place.
