CHAPTER 472, LAWS OF 1969

AN ACT to amend 15.08 (7); and to repeal and recreate 15.405 (3) of the statutes, relating to the athletic examining board.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. 15.08 (7) of the statutes is amended to read:

15.08 (7) Each member of an examining board shall, unless he is a full-time salaried employe of this state, be paid a per diem of \$25 for each day on which he was actually and necessarily engaged in the performance of his duties. Each member of an examining board shall be reimbursed for his actual and necessary expenses incurred in the perform-

ance of his duties. *Inspectors appointed by the athletic examining board shall be paid a per diem to be set by the examining board, but not to exceed \$10 for each day on which they are actually and necessarily engaged in the performance of their duties and shall be reimbursed for their actual and necessary expenses incurred in the performance of their duties.*

SECTION 2. 15.405 (3) of the statutes is repealed and recreated to read:

15.405 (3) ATHLETIC EXAMINING BOARD. There is created an athletic examining board in the department of regulation and licensing. The athletic examining board shall consist of 3 members appointed for staggered 3-year terms. The secretary shall file a bond under s. 19.01 in the sum of \$2,000 with surety approved by the examining board. The secretary may receive such additional compensation, not to exceed \$2,400 per year, as the examining board directs.

SECTION 3. Of the members first appointed under section 15.405 (3) of the statutes, as affected by this act, one each shall be appointed for a term expiring on July 1 in 1970, 1971 and 1972. Thereafter, appointments shall be made in accordance with s. 15.405 (3).
