CHAPTER 22, Laws of 1971

AN ACT to amend 29.14 (4) and 29.145 (1) of the statutes, relating to requiring fishing licenses for nonresidents netting smelt and nongame fish.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. 29.14 (4) of the statutes is amended to read:

29.14 (4) Any nonresident in possession of a duly issued non-resident fishing license of current issue is permitted to take minnows for bait or smelt for food under the same conditions and rules governing residents. Smelt may be taken without a license by any nonresident under the same conditions and rules governing residents. However, no such minnows or smelt taken by nonresidents shall may be sold, traded or bartered in any manner.

SECTION 2. 29.145 (1) of the statutes is amended to read:

29.145 (1) Any resident under the age of 16 years or over the age of 65 years and any physically or mentally handicapped individual committed to the north, south or central colony and training school, during the period of their commitment may without license take, catch or kill fish subject to all other provisions of law; but no other resident between the ages of 16 and 65 years shall may take, catch or kill fish, or fish for fish with hook and line or with rod and reel in any of the waters of this state unless a resident fishing license has been duly issued to him, subject to all other provisions of law, but no license shall be required of any person resident to set, place or use in any waters in this state any landing net, dip net, minnow seine or minnow dip net for fish other than game fish.
