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CHAPTER 111, Laws of 1975

AN ACT to amend 120.50 (4) (a) of the statutes, relating to required advance notice given to fiscal board members of fiscal board meetings.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

120.50 (4) (a) of the statutes is amended to read:

120.50 (4) (a) Not less than 48 ~~72~~ hours prior to a meeting of the fiscal board, the city clerk shall notify in writing each alderman, town chairman, village president and mayor under sub. (2) (b) of the time and place of the meeting. An emergency fiscal board meeting may be held without prior written notice, if each alderman, town chairman, village president and mayor under sub. (2) (b) is notified by telephone or other means as far as possible in advance of such meeting and if each town chairman, village president and mayor and a majority of the aldermen under sub. (2) are present and consent or if every such person consents in writing even though he does not attend.
