1983 Wisconsin Act 1

AN ACT *relating to* the authorized date for a special election to fill a vacancy in the senate from the 12th senate district in 1983.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. Date for special election and related events. Notwithstanding section 8.50 (2) (a) of the statutes, the governor may issue an order not later than January 7, 1983, calling for a special primary and election under section 8.50 of the statutes to be held concurrently with the 1983 spring primary and election to fill a vacancy in the senate from the 12th senate district. If an order is issued under this SECTION, the elections board and the appropriate county clerks shall publish a type A notice of the election under section 10.01 (2) (a) of the statutes not later than January 10, 1983. Notwithstanding section 8.50 (3) (a) of the statutes, nomination papers for an election called under this order may be filed not later than 5 p.m. on January 18, 1983.
