1983 Wisconsin Act 13

AN ACT to authorize and direct expenditure of \$3,654.01 from the general fund for payment of a claim against the state made by Gareth Foerster.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. Claim against the state. There is authorized and directed to be expended from the appropriation under section 20.505 (4) (d) of the statutes, as affected by the acts of 1983, \$3,654.01 in payment of a claim against the state by Gareth Foerster, Stanley, Wisconsin, to compensate him for attorney fees and costs in connection with the defense of charges filed against him for misconduct in public office arising as the result of a theft that occurred at the university of Wisconsin-Eau Claire in 1982. The charges were later dropped. Acceptance of this payment operates as a full and complete release to the state for any claim resulting from expenses incurred by the claimant in connection with that incident.
