## 1983 Wisconsin Act 26

AN ACT to renumber and amend 125.69 (1) (b); and to create 125.33 (1) (cm) and 125.69 (1) (b) 2 of the statutes, relating to alcohol beverage wholesalers' interest in retail premises.

*The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:*

SECTION 1. 125.33 (1) (cm) of the statutes is created to read:

125.33 (1) (cm) Notwithstanding the prohibitions in this subsection, a wholesaler may have an interest in a corporation that owns and operates a golf course and leases premises on the golf course to the holder of a Class "B" license or permit for the premises, if the wholesaler's license and the Class "B" license or permit were originally issued to the corporation and to the Class "B" licensee or permittee before June 1, 1981. The wholesaler's license and the Class "B" license or permit shall be renewed annually upon application, unless revoked under s. 125.12. An application for a wholesaler's license to which this paragraph applies shall have attached to it an affidavit stating the applicant's interest in the Class "B" premises.

SECTION 2. 125.69 (1) (b) of the statutes is renumbered 125.69 (1) (b) 1 and amended to read:

125.69 (1) (b) 1. ~~No~~ Except as provided under subd. 2, no intoxicating liquor manufacturer, rectifier or wholesaler may hold any direct or indirect interest in any "Class B" license or permit or establishment and no "Class B" licensee or permittee may hold any direct or indirect interest in a wholesale permit or establishment.

SECTION 3. 125.69 (1) (b) 2 of the statutes is created to read:

125.69 (1) (b) 2. A wholesaler may have an interest in a corporation that owns and operates a golf course and leases premises on the golf course to the holder of a "Class B" license or permit for the premises, if the wholesaler's permit and the "Class B" license or permit were originally issued to the corporation and to the "Class B" licensee or permittee before June 1, 1981. The wholesaler's permit and "Class B" license or permit shall be renewed annually, unless revoked under s. 125.12. An application for a wholesaler's permit to which this paragraph applies shall have attached to it an affidavit stating the applicant's interest in the "Class B" premises.
