1983 Wisconsin Act 343

AN ACT *to repeal* 349.18 (intro.); and *to amend* 349.18 (title), 349.18 (1) and 349.18 (2) of the statutes, *relating to* authorizing regulation and registration of bicycles by towns.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. 349.18 (title) of the statutes is amended to read:

349.18 (title) Additional traffic-control authority of cities, towns and villages.

SECTION 2. 349.18 (intro.) of the statutes is repealed.

SECTION 3. 349.18 (1) of the statutes is amended to read:

349.18 (1) ~~Designate~~ Any city or village may by ordinance designate the number of persons that may ride on a power driven cycle or motor bicycle at any one time and the highways upon which a power driven cycle, motor bicycle or moped may or may not be operated;

SECTION 4. 349.18 (2) of the statutes is amended to read:

349.18 (2) ~~Regulate~~ Any city, town or village may by ordinance regulate the operation of bicycles and require their registration, including the payment of a registration fee.
