## 1985 Wisconsin Act 192

AN ACT to amend 36.27 (2) (cm); and to create 36.27 (2m) of the statutes, relating to the exemption from nonresident tuition at the university of Wisconsin system for persons who move to this state to accept full-time employment.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. 36.27 (2) (cm) of the statutes, as created by 1985 Wisconsin Act 51, is amended to read:

36.27 (2) (cm) Any student person continuously employed full time by a private business located in this state, who was relocated to this state for business purposes by his or her current employer or who has moved to this state for business purposes and accepted his or her current employment with a business located in this state before applying for admission to an institution or center and before moving to this state, and the spouse of any such student person, is entitled to the exemption under par. (a), if that the student intends demonstrates an intent to establish and main-

tain a permanent home in Wisconsin, as determined by according to the criteria set forth in under par. (e).

SECTION 2. 36.27 (2m) of the statutes is created to read:

36.27 (2m) APPEALS. Any body designated by the board to hear appeals regarding nonresident tuition exemptions under sub. (2) may require a student who has been granted such an exemption to submit information from which the body may determine the student's continuing eligibility for the exemption, the student's eligibility for a different exemption or the student's residency status.

SECTION 3. Effective date. This act takes effect on May 1, 1986.
