## 1989 WISCONSIN ACT 50

AN ACT to renumber 181.32 and 181.67 (3); and to create 20.907 (1m), 181.32 (2) and 181.67 (3) (b) of the statutes, relating to: reports by charitable organizations and state agencies.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

**SECTION 1.** 20.907 (1m) of the statutes is created to read:

20.907 (1m) REPORTING. State agencies shall, by December 1 annually, submit a report to the joint committee on finance and the department of administration on expenditures made by the agency during the preceding fiscal year from nonfederal funds received as gifts, grants, bequests or devises. The department of administration shall prescribe a form, which the department may modify as appropriate for the various state agencies, that each state agency must use to report its expenditures as required under this subsection. The form shall require the expenditures to be reported in aggregate amounts as determined by the department of administration. The report shall also include a listing of in–kind contributions, including goods and services, received and used by the state agency during the preceding fiscal year.

**SECTION 2.** 181.32 of the statutes is renumbered 181.32 (1).

**SECTION 3.** 181.32 (2) of the statutes is created to read:

181.32 (2) Upon issuing a certificate of incorporation, the secretary of state shall inform the corporation of the reporting requirements under s. 440.41 for charitable organizations that solicit contributions.

**SECTION 4.** 181.67 (3) of the statutes is renumbered 181.67 (3) (a).

**SECTION 5.** 181.67 (3) (b) of the statutes is created to read:

181.67 (3) (b) The secretary of state shall forward to the department of regulation and licensing the name and address of any corporation filing articles of incorporation under this chapter.

**SECTION 6. Initial applicability.** (1) STATE AGENCY REPORTS. The treatment of section 20.907 (1m) of the statutes first applies to expenditures by state agencies that are made, and in–kind contributions that are received and used by state agencies, during the first full fiscal year following the effective date of this subsection.

(2) CHARITABLE ORGANIZATION REPORTS. The treatment of sections 181.32 and 181.67 (3) of the statutes and the creation of sections 181.32 (2) and 181.67 (3) (b) of the statutes first apply to certificates of incorporation issued by the secretary of state and articles of incorporation filed with the secretary of state on the effective date of this subsection.
