1989 WISCONSIN ACT 58

AN ACT to direct expenditure of \$7,140 from the general fund for payment of a claim against the state made by Walter Grisa.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. Claim against the state. There is directed to be expended from the appropriation under section 20.465 (1) (c) of the statutes, as affected by the acts of 1987 and 1989, \$7,140 in payment of a claim against the state made by Walter Grisa, Minoqua, Wis-

consin, to compensate him for the loss of mink kits on his mink farm as the result of a disturbance caused by Wisconsin national guard helicopters operating at low altitudes over the farm during the period from April 18, 1988, to May 1, 1988. Acceptance of this payment releases this state and its officers, employes and agents from any further liability with respect to this activity.
