1993 WISCONSIN ACT 431

AN ACT to direct expenditure of \$38,092.69 from moneys appropriated to the department of transportation for payment of a claim against the state made by James Peterson Sons, Inc.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. Claim against the state. There is directed to be expended from the following appropriations, as affected by the acts of 1993, in payment of a claim against the state made by James Peterson Sons, Inc., Medford, Wisconsin, as reimbursement for unanticipated fuel cost increases under road paving contracts entered into with the department of transportation prior to August 8, 1990:

SECTION 2. Release. Acceptance of the payment authorized in SECTION 1 releases this state from any further liability resulting from fuel cost increases incurred by the claimant under all contracts specified in SECTION 1.
