1997 WISCONSIN ACT 212

AN ACT to create 16.72 (8) of the statutes; relating to: stationery utilized by state agencies for outside correspondence.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. 16.72 (8) of the statutes is created to read:

16.72 (8) The department shall ensure that every agency includes on all stationery utilized by the agency for correspondence outside the agency at least one telephone number where the agency may be contacted, at least one facsimile transmission number for the agency, if the agency has such a number, and at least one electron-

ic mail address for the agency, if the agency has such an address.

SECTION 2. Nonstatutory provisions.

(1) Notwithstanding section 16.72 (8) of the statutes, as created by this act, an agency which, on the effective date of this subsection, has in its possession or has committed to purchase stationery which does not comply with section 16.72 (8) of the statutes, as created by this act, may continue to utilize that stationery until its supply is exhausted.

"Every act and every portion of an act enacted by the legislature over the governor's partial veto which does not expressly prescribe the time when it takes effect shall take effect on the day after its date of publication as designated" by the secretary of state [the date of publication may not be more than 10 working days after the date of enactment].
