2005 WISCONSIN ACT 144

AN ACT *to amend* 346.91 of the statutes; **relating to:** crossing a fire hose that is being used in an emergency situation.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. 346.91 of the statutes is amended to read:
346.91 Crossing fire hose. No person without the

consent of the fire department official in command may drive a vehicle over any unprotected hose of a fire department when such hose is laid down on any street or private driveway to be used at any fire or alarm of fire training exercise, scene of an emergency, or alarm of emergency.

* Section 991.11, WISCONSIN STATUTES 2003-04 : Effective date of acts. "Every act and every portion of an act enacted by the legislature over the governor's partial veto which does not expressly prescribe the time when it takes effect shall take effect on the day after its date of publication as designated" by the secretary of state [the date of publication may not be more than 10 working days after the date of enactment].
