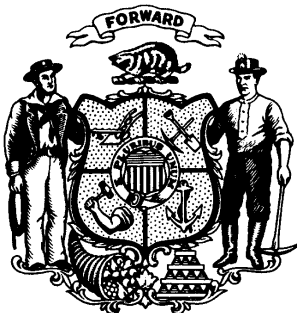

2013 WISCONSIN ACT 104

AN ACT *to repeal and recreate* 108.02 (15) (k) 16. of the statutes; **relating to:** coverage of certain individuals engaged in sales activity outside a permanent retail establishment under the unemployment insurance law.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. 108.02 (15) (k) 16. of the statutes is repealed and recreated to read:

108.02 (15) (k) 16. By an individual who is engaged, in a home or otherwise than in a permanent retail establishment, in the service of selling or soliciting the sale of

consumer products for use, sale, or resale by the buyer, if substantially all of the remuneration therefor is directly related to the sales or other output related to sales rather than to hours worked.

SECTION 2. Initial applicability.

(1) This act first applies with respect to services performed after the December 31 following the effective date of this subsection.

* Section 991.11, WISCONSIN STATUTES: Effective date of acts. "Every act and every portion of an act enacted by the legislature over the governor's partial veto which does not expressly prescribe the time when it takes effect shall take effect on the day after its date of publication."
