TRANSPORTATION OF FARM PRODUCTS BY CONTRACT CARRIERS, 35-MILE RADIUS

PSC 34.01 Additional authority; commission finding
PSC 34.02 Licenses amended

PSC 34.01 Additional authority; commission finding. All contract motor carriers who are by their licenses authorized to transport specifically or generally farm products, other than milk or cream, for the public in intrastate commerce from specified farm origin territory shall be authorized, in addition to their present authority:

(1) To transport such specific items of farm products as are designated in the license from said farm origin territory to any point within a radius of 35 miles of the residence or principal place of business of the carrier;

(2) To transport farm supplies from any point within such 35-mile radius to farms within said farm origin territory; and

(3) To transport horses, cattle to be used for dairy or breeding purposes, and goods sold or offered for sale at farm auction sales between such farm origin territory and any point within the state for farmers located in said farm origin territory.

PSC 34.02 Licenses amended. (1) All contract motor carrier licenses which are within the classification described in the foregoing finding [section PSC 34.01, introductory paragraph] and which contain authority to engage in taxable operations shall be amended so as to include the additional authority enumerated in said finding [section PSC 34.01].

(2) All contract motor carrier licenses which are within the classification described in the foregoing finding [section PSC 34.01, introductory paragraph] and which contain no authority to engage in taxable work shall be amended so as to include the additional authority set forth in the first item of said finding [section PSC 34.01(1)], and in addition thereto, the transportation of horses, cattle to be used for dairy or breeding purposes, and farm products sold at farm auction sales between the farm origin territory respectively specified in said licenses and any point within the state for farmers located in said origin territory.

(3) The license of any contract motor carrier falling within the second of the foregoing classifications shall be, upon the request of such carrier, amended so as to include all of the additional authority enumerated in the foregoing finding [section PSC 34.01].

Note: This order applies only to contract motor carrier licenses which were outstanding and in effect on May 26, 1936. Chapter 339, Laws of 1937, repealed section 76.54 (16), Statutes, and created section 194.47 to exempt farm supplies from the motor transportation tax. Chapter 320, Laws of 1953, repealed sections 194.47, 194.48, 194.49, and 194.50, Statutes, which provided exemptions from motor transportation tax.
