

(10) WAUSHARA COUNTY. (a) *Greenwood.*

Township 19 north, range 8 east, town of Hancock.

Section 11—All that part of the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ lying north and east of Forest Drive Road.

Section 12—All that part of the W $\frac{1}{2}$ of the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ and of the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ lying east of Forest Drive Road and south of CTH "GG".

Section 3—All islands and sand bars in the W $\frac{3}{4}$ of the S $\frac{1}{2}$ within the navigable waters of the Wisconsin River.

Section 4—All islands and sand bars within the navigable waters of the Wisconsin River.

Township 12 north, range 8 east, town of Caledonia.

Section 3—All that part of the W $\frac{3}{4}$ of the S $\frac{1}{2}$ in the town of Caledonia, including all islands and sand bars within the navigable waters of the Wisconsin River.

Section 4—Entire section in the town of Caledonia including all islands and sand bars in said section lying within the navigable waters of the Wisconsin River.

Section 9—All that part lying north of the Interstate Highway.

Section 10—W $\frac{1}{2}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$, NW $\frac{1}{4}$, SW $\frac{1}{4}$, W $\frac{1}{2}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$.

Section 15—All that part of the W $\frac{3}{4}$ of the N $\frac{1}{2}$ lying north of the Interstate Highway.

Section 16—All that part of the NE NE lying north of the Interstate Highway.

Section 33—That part of the east half which is surrounded by town roads on the west, north and easterly sides and by state highway 13 on the south.
