

Chapter NR 217**INTERIM EFFLUENT LIMITATIONS
WISCONSIN POLLUTANT DISCHARGE
ELIMINATION SYSTEM**

NR 217.01 Purpose
NR 217.10 Application of interim effluent limitations

Note: Pursuant to Chapter 74, Laws of 1973, in sections 147.04 (3) and (5) and under the procedure of section 227.027, Wis. Stats., the department of natural resources has promulgated interim effluent limitations which become effective February 1, 1974 and will remain in effect for a period of one year. These interim effluent limitations will be periodically replaced by permanent effluent limitations.

NR 217.01 Purpose. The purpose of this chapter is to provide for the application of interim effluent limitations in permits for discharges from point sources other than publicly owned waste treatment works which are not subject to the interim effluent limitations in NR chapters 221 to 299, Wis. Adm. Code, inclusive, as authorized by section 147.04 (5), Wis. Stats.

NR 217.10 Application of interim effluent limitations. (1) The department may specify interim effluent limitations applicable in permits for the discharge from facilities:

(a) Which do not conform to the classes or categories of point sources identified in NR 220,

(b) Which belong to classes or categories of point sources for which interim effluent limitations have not been adopted in NR chapters 221 to 299 inclusive, or

(c) Which belong to classes or categories of point sources excluded from, or not specifically included in, the applicability provisions of the interim effluent limitations of NR chapter 221 to 299 inclusive.

(2) In permits for discharges from facilities identified in subsection (1) of this chapter effluent limitations pursuant to this chapter shall be those which the department determines are achievable by the application of the best practicable waste treatment technology.

(a) In making such determinations the department shall in part be guided where appropriate by transferrable technology described as illustrating best practicable control technology, and by effluent limitations resulting therefrom, in NR chapters 221 to 299.
