FOREIGN PHYSICIAN—TEMPORARY LICENSE

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Med 13.01 Requirements. A foreign graduate physician who applies for a temporary license to practice medicine and surgery in a specified location in this state, as provided in section 448.03(4), Wis. Stats., must show proof of having passed the Educational Council for Foreign Medical Graduates examination and must present the standard certificate.

Med 13.02 Letter of request. The applicant must file with the board one or letters requesting his services in a specified location in this state where he plans to practice.

Med 13.03 Fee. The fee for a temporary license is \$25.00.

Med 13.04 Renewals. The temporary license will be issued for a 4 month period and may be renewed twice. The fee for each renewal will be \$25.00 and may be renewed at the discretion of the board.

Med 13.05 Personal interview. The applicant shall be examined by at least 2 members of the board to determine his educational background and training and knowledge of the English language.

Med 13.06 Additional requirements. The applicant must meet all statutory and board requirements for a foreign graduate or regular license, depending upon qualifications, after the expiration of the temporary license in order to continue practice in Wisconsin.
