A closed season is established on the following described areas, and it is unlawful for any person to take, catch, kill, hunt, or pursue with the use of firearms or bow and arrow any species of wild animals or birds thereon during the periods established in Wis. Adm. Code section NR 10.01 (1) as open seasons on waterfowl.
