RAILROAD CROSSING ADVANCE WARNING SIGNS

**Hy 17.01 General.** (1) **AUTHORITY FOR THESE REGULATIONS.** Pursuant to authority contained in section 192.48(2), Wis. Stats., the commission hereby specifies the details of the design of the standard railroad crossing advance warning sign.

(2) **GENERAL SPECIFICATIONS AND STANDARDS.** These signs shall conform substantially to the detailed design specifications given herein. Minor variations in size of sign and in dimensions of letters, border, and symbol will be permitted.

**Hy 17.02 Detailed design of railroad crossing advance warning sign.** (1) **SHAPE.** A circle.

(2) **SIZE.** Minimum diameter of sign shall be 30 inches.

(3) **COLORS.** Black letters, symbol, and border on a yellow background.

(4) **LETTERING.** "R-R," height 6 inches, stroke  $1\frac{1}{8}$  inches on minimum diameter sign.

(5) **MESSAGE.** Diagonal cross consisting of two black bands each  $2\frac{1}{2}$  inches in width at right angles to each other and 45 degrees to the vertical, with a letter "R" in each of the right and left quadrants.

(6) **SIGN LARGER THAN MINIMUM.** In signs larger than the 30-inch diameter minimum, the dimensions of the letters, symbol, and border shall be increased in proportion to the increase in sign diameter.
