El Bd 2.05 Nomination paper sufficiency

El Bd 2.05 Nomination paper sufficiency. (1) Any information which appears on the face of a nomination paper is entitled to a presumption of validity by the board.

(2) Where any required item of information on a nomination paper is incomplete as to a portion thereof the board will accept the information as complete if there has been substantial compliance with the law.

(3) Where it is alleged that the signer or circulator of a nomination paper does not reside within the district in which the candidate being nominated seeks office, the board will attempt to ascertain the geographical location of an address indicated on the face of a nomination paper by consulting with the appropriate postmaster or other public official.
