- RR 6.01 Type of use. (1) The county highway committee, with approval of the rustic roads board, may designate a portion of the roadway or the area adjacent to the roadway of rustic road for the exclusive use of bicyclists and/or pedestrians. If a portion of the roadway is so designated for the exclusive use of bicyclists and/or pedestrians, the county highway committee, with concurrence of the rustic roads board, may paint lines, establish priority of right of way, and construct such dividers to physically separate vehicular, bicycle or pedestrian traffic as deemed necessary.
- (2) The designation of the entire roadway for the exclusive use of bicyclists and/or pedestrians is prohibited, as it makes the road no longer a highway and ineligible for highway aid funds.
- (3) The county highway committee, with concurrence of the rustic roads board, may also designate or restrict the type of vehicular traffic permitted on a rustic road.
- (4) The county highway committee, with concurrence of the rustic roads board, may designate a rustic road as one-way or two-way operation.

RR 6.02 Speed limits. The county highway committee, with concurrence of the state highway commission, shall establish a reasonable speed limit to ensure compatibility between the recreational driver, the bicyclist, and the hiker.
