BC 9.01 Restoration of license. Any person who held a license as a practitioner, manager, aesthetician, electrologist or manicurist and who failed to renew the license on or before the date of its expiration may renew the license as follows:

(1) If the application for renewal is filed less than 30 days after the expiration of the applicant's last license, the applicant may renew the license by payment of the fees specified in s. 440.08 (2) (a) 5, 18, 20, 30, or 46 and (3) (a) 1, Stats.

(2) If the application for renewal is filed 30 days or more, but less than 5 years after the expiration of the applicant's last license, the applicant may renew the license by payment of the fees specified in s. 440.08 (2) (a) 5, 18, 20, 30, or 46 and (3) (a) 2, Stats.

(3) If the application for renewal is 5 years or more after the expiration of the applicant's last license, the applicant may renew the license by completing the requirements for obtaining an initial license under s. 454.06(2), (3), (4), (5), or (6), Stats.

BC 9.02 Reinstatement of license. Any former licensee whose license has been suspended or revoked may be reinstated upon a determination by the board that the violation of the statute or rule which was the basis for the disciplinary action originally taken has been corrected. The board may require theory instruction, continuing education, practical training and examination as conditions for reinstatement of a suspended or revoked license.
