structures which have or may be affected by gas migration shall be identified.

(11) Proposed remedial actions necessary to return the facility to compliance with the requirements of s. NR 504.04 (4) shall be proposed and shall be evaluated utilizing the process in ch. NR 722, including a practicability determination in accordance with s. NR 722.07 (5). Sections NR 140.24 (4) and 140.26 (2) outline the required set of remedial actions to address groundwater impacts depending on what parameters are affected and whether or not a preventive action limit or enforcement standard has been exceeded. Any soil contamination shall be addressed in compliance with the requirements of ch. NR 720. A long-term environmental monitoring program shall be proposed so the performance of the facility and the effects of any remedial action can be evaluated. The department may issue a determination that no further remedial action is necessary at the facility pursuant to ch. NR 726.
