NHA 2.01 Examinations. (1) The board shall determine the subjects for examination of applicants for license as a nursing home administrator. The scope, content, form and character of the examinations shall be the same for all candidates.

(2) Examinations shall be held at a time and place designated by the board.

(3) The examination shall consist of the following:

(a) Part I - the national examination prepared by NAB, and

(b) Part II - the state law examination prepared by the board.

NHA 2.02 Application for examination. (1) An applicant for examination for license as a nursing home administrator shall make application on a form approved by the board at least 30 days prior to the date of the examination. The board shall notify the applicant within 30 business days of receipt of a completed application whether the application is approved or denied. The applicant shall also submit to the board:

(a) Two letters which attest to the applicant's suitability to practice as a nursing home administrator from individuals not related to or employed by the applicant who have known the applicant for at least 3 years;

(b) A current, passport-type photograph of the applicant; and,

(c) Evidence of having completed any one of the following: 1. A regular course of study;

2. A program of study or,

3. Specialized courses.

(d) The fees specified in s. 440.05 (1), Stats.

(2) Upon successful completion of the examination, an applicant who applies under:

(a) Subsection (1) (c) 2 shall provide evidence of having completed 6 months of experience in the field of institutional administration.

(b) Subsection (1) (c) 3 shall provide evidence of having completed one year of experience in the field of institutional administration.

NHA 2.03 Subject areas for examination. Every applicant for a license as a nursing home administrator after meeting the requirements for qualification for examination shall successfully pass an examination which may include any of the following general subject areas in nursing home administration:

(1) General administration of a licensed nursing home.

(2) Long-term patient care.

(3) Organization of health-care systems.
