**Opt 7.01 Definitions.** In this chapter, "department" means the department of regulation and licensing.

Opt 7.02 Certificate of registration. Persons practicing optometry are required to hold a valid certificate of registration. History: Cr. Register, January, 1993, No. 445, eff. 2-1-93.

Opt 7.03 Renewal of certificate. Persons practicing optometry shall on or before January 1 of each even-numbered year renew their certificates of registration by registering with the department and paying the renewal fee specified in s. 440.08 (2) (a). Stats

**Opt 7.04 Failure to renew.** An optometrist who fails to renew a certificate of registration by the renewal date may not practice optometry, until the certificate is restored under s. Opt. 7.05.

**Opt 7.05 Late renewal.** An optometrist who fails to renew a certificate of registration by the renewal date may restore the certificate by satisfying the following requirements:

- (1) If applying less than 5 years after the renewal date, submit an application on a form provided by the department and pay the renewal fees specified in s. 440.08 (2) (a) and (3), Stats.
- (2) If applying 5 years or more after the renewal date, submit an application on a form provided by the department, pay the renewal fees specified in s. 440.08 (2) (a) and (3), Stats., and submit proof of:
- (a) Successful completion of educational coursework required by the board to ensure protection of the public health, safety and welfare, and
