H 38.01 Laboratory examinations

H 38.01 Laboratory examinations. The following laboratory examinations are designated as necessary for the protection of the health of the public:

- (1) Examinations of water
 - (a) Tests for coliform bacteria
- (2) Examinations of milk
 - (a) Plate counts
 - (b) Direct microscopic counts
 - (c) Coliform plate tests
 - (d) Coliform tube tests
 - (e) Methylene blue reduction tests
 - (f) Resazurin reduction tests
 - (g) Phosphatase tests
 - (h) Residual antibiotics
- (3) Enteric bacteriological examinations
- (4) Serologic examinations for syphilis
