



**SENATE AMENDMENT 1,
TO 1995 ASSEMBLY BILL 1048**

May 7, 1996 – Offered by Senators PANZER, JAUCH, PETAK and C. POTTER.

1 At the locations indicated, amend the bill, as shown by assembly substitute
amendment 1, as follows:

2 **1. Page 1, line 12:** before “imposing” insert: “contributions to the fast start
fund of the Wisconsin Advanced Telecommunications Foundation, the subscription
service for prospective state vendors, a state bidders list and registration fee,”.

3 **2. Page 1, line 13:** on page 1, line 5, of the material inserted by assembly
amendment 1, delete “and” and substitute a comma.

4 **3. Page 1, line 13:** before the period insert “and making an appropriation”,
which was deleted by assembly amendment 1.

5 **4. Page 2, line 1:** before that line insert:

6 “**SECTION 1b.** 14.28 (6) (a) 2. of the statutes is amended to read:

7 14.28 (6) (a) 2. Before January 1, ~~1997~~ 1998, in addition to the amount under
8 subd. 1., a total of \$3,000,000, at least 50% of which shall be in direct contributions.

9 **SECTION 1c.** 16.701 of the statutes, as created by 1995 Wisconsin Act 27, is
10 amended to read:

1 **16.701 Subscription service.** The department may provide a subscription
2 service containing current information of interest to prospective vendors concerning
3 state procurement opportunities. If the department provides the service, the
4 department shall assist small businesses, as defined in s. 16.75 (4) (c), who are
5 prospective vendors in accessing and using the service by providing facilities or
6 services to the businesses. The department shall charge a fee for any such service.
7 The department shall prescribe the amount of the fee by rule.

8 **SECTION 1d.** 16.7015 of the statutes is created to read:

9 **16.7015 Bidders list.** The department or any agency to which the department
10 delegates purchasing authority under s. 16.71 (1) may maintain a bidders list which
11 shall include the names and addresses of all persons who request to be notified of bids
12 or competitive sealed proposals to be solicited by the department or other agency for
13 the procurement of materials, supplies, equipment or contractual services under this
14 subchapter. Any list maintained by the department may include the names and
15 addresses of any person who requests to be notified of bids or competitive sealed
16 proposals to be solicited by any agency. The department or other agency shall notify
17 each person on its list of all requests for bids or competitive sealed proposals by the
18 department or other agency. The department or other agency may remove any
19 person from its list for cause.

20 **SECTION 1df.** 16.702 of the statutes, as affected by 1995 Wisconsin Acts 27 and
21 (this act), is repealed.

22 **SECTION 1e.** 16.702 (title) of the statutes, as created by 1995 Wisconsin Act 27,
23 is amended to read:

24 **16.702 (title) ~~Contract administration fees~~ Bidders list registration fee.**

1 **SECTION 1f.** 16.702 (1) of the statutes, as created by 1995 Wisconsin Act 27, is
2 amended to read:

3 16.702 (1) The department shall by rule prescribe a ~~contract administration~~
4 bidders list registration fee to be paid for each state fiscal year by ~~providers of~~
5 ~~materials, supplies, equipment or contractual services to agencies.~~ Different
6 ~~contract administration fees may be assessed on the basis of different total dollar~~
7 ~~volumes of sales by providers to agencies within the fiscal year in which the fee is~~
8 ~~assessed or the preceding fiscal year~~ any person who requests to be placed on a list
9 maintained under s. 16.7015 and who is placed on such a list for any portion of that
10 fiscal year. Payment of the fee to the department entitles the payer, upon the payer's
11 request, to be placed on each list maintained under s. 16.7015 that is specified by the
12 payer during the fiscal year for which the fee is paid, except as provided in s. 16.7015.

13 **SECTION 1g.** 16.702 (2) of the statutes, as created by 1995 Wisconsin Act 27, is
14 repealed.

15 **SECTION 1h.** 16.702 (3) (b) of the statutes, as created by 1995 Wisconsin Act 27,
16 is amended to read:

17 16.702 (3) (b) Exemption of any class of ~~providers~~ persons from payment of part
18 or all of the fee prescribed under sub. (1) if exemption of that class of ~~providers~~
19 persons is in the best interest of the state.”.

20 **5.** Page 2, line 1: substitute “**SECTION 1m**” for “**SECTION 1**”.

21 **6.** Page 2, line 23: after that line insert:

22 “**SECTION 4m.** 25.61 of the statutes, as created by 1995 Wisconsin Act 27, is
23 amended to read:

1 **25.61 Information technology investment fund.** There is created a
2 separate nonlapsible trust fund designated as the information technology
3 investment fund consisting of all revenues accruing to the state from fees assessed
4 under ss. s. 16.701, 16.702 and from gifts, grants and bequests made for information
5 technology development purposes and moneys transferred to the fund from other
6 funds.”.

7 **7. Page 18, line 15:** after that line, on page 2, line 3, of the material inserted
by assembly amendment 1, substitute “\$170,000,000” for “\$195,000,000”.

8 **8. Page 19, line 23:** after that line insert:

9 “(6x) PIONEERING PARTNERS APPROPRIATION. Notwithstanding section 16.42 (1)
10 (e) of the statutes, in submitting information under section 16.42 of the statutes for
11 the purposes of the 1997–99 biennial budget bill, the department of administration
12 shall submit information concerning the appropriation under section 20.505 (4) (er)
13 of the statutes as though the change in the dollar amount of that appropriation by
14 SECTION 42m (1) of this act had not been made.”.

15 **9. Page 19, line 24:** on page 2, line 11, of the material inserted by assembly
amendment 1, substitute “\$180,635,900” for “\$205,635,900”.

16 **10. Page 19, line 24:** on page 2, line 16, of the material inserted by assembly
amendment 1, delete “\$10,000,000” and substitute “\$5,000,000”.

17 **11. Page 20, line 8:** before that line insert:

18 “**SECTION 42m. Appropriation changes.**

19 (1) PIONEERING PARTNERS GRANTS. In the schedule under section 20.005 (3) of the
20 statutes for the appropriation to the department of administration under section
21 20.505 (4) (er) of the statutes, as affected by the acts of 1995, the dollar amount is

1 increased by \$5,000,000 for fiscal year 1996-97 to increase funding for the purpose
2 for which the appropriation is made.”.

3 **12.** Page 20, line 18: after that line, after the material inserted by assembly
amendment 1, insert:

4 “(4x) PIONEERING PARTNERS GRANTS. SECTION 42m (1) of this act takes effect on
5 January 1, 1997.

6 (4y) BIDDERS LIST REGISTRATION FEE CREATION. The treatment of section 16.702
7 (title), (1), (2) and (3) (b) of the statutes takes effect on July 1, 1996.

8 (4z) BIDDERS LIST REGISTRATION FEE EXPIRATION. The repeal of section 16.702 of
9 the statutes and the treatment of section 25.61 of the statutes take effect on July 1,
10 2000.”.
