134.66 (2) (f) No retailer and no retailer's employe or agent may sell cigarettes

**4.** Page 7, line 17: after that line insert:

or tobacco products, other than cigars, by mail order.".

"Section 28m. 134.66 (4) (a) 1. of the statutes is amended to read:

134.66 (4) (a) 1. In this paragraph, "violation" means a violation of sub. (2) (a),

(c), (cm), (d) or, (e) or (f) or of a local ordinance which strictly conforms to sub. (2) (a),

(c), (cm), (d) or (e) that is enacted in compliance with sub. (5).".
