ASSEMBLY SUBSTITUTE AMENDMENT 1, TO 1995 ASSEMBLY BILL 112

October 26, 1995 – Offered by Committee on Criminal Justice and Corrections.

1	AN ACT to repeal 165.83 (2) (a) 3.; to renumber and amend 165.83 (2) (b); and
2	<i>to amend</i> 165.83 (2) (a) 2., 165.83 (2) (g) and 165.83 (2) (h) of the statutes;
3	relating to: obtaining fingerprints and other information from persons who
4	are arrested or taken into custody.
	The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:
5	SECTION 1. 165.83 (2) (a) 2. of the statutes is amended to read:
6	165.83 (2) (a) 2. For an offense which that is a misdemeanor under ch. 161, 940,
7	941 or 948, a misdemeanor arising out of an arrest for a domestic abuse incident
8	under s. 968.075, a violation of s. 813.12 (8) (a), or a violation of an ordinance
9	involving burglary tools, commercial gambling, dealing in gambling devices,
10	contributing to the delinquency of a child, dealing in stolen property, controlled
11	substances under ch. 161, firearms, dangerous weapons, explosives, pandering,
12	prostitution, sex offenses where children are victims, or worthless checks.
13	SECTION 2. 165.83 (2) (a) 3. of the statutes is repealed.

1	SECTION 3. 165.83 (2) (b) of the statutes is renumbered 165.83 (3) and amended
2	to read:
3	165.83 (3) Accept <u>The department may accept</u> for filing <u>, and may keep on file</u>
4	or in a data base, fingerprints and other identifying data, taken at the discretion of
5	the law enforcement or tribal law enforcement agency involved, on persons arrested
6	or taken into custody for offenses other than those listed in par. <u>sub. (2)</u> (a).
7	SECTION 4. 165.83 (2) (g) of the statutes is amended to read:
8	165.83 (2) (g) Furnish all reporting officials with forms and instructions which
9	specify in detail the nature of the information required under pars. (a) to (f) <u>and sub.</u>
10	(3) and any other matters which facilitate collection.
11	SECTION 5. 165.83 (2) (h) of the statutes is amended to read:
12	165.83 (2) (h) Cooperate with and assist all law enforcement and tribal law
13	enforcement agencies in the state in the establishment of a state system of criminal
14	identification and in obtaining fingerprints and other identifying data on all persons
15	described in pars. (a) , (b) and (c) <u>and sub. (3)</u> .
16	SECTION 6. Initial applicability.
17	(1) This act first applies to fingerprints and other identifying data obtained
18	from persons arrested or taken into custody on the effective date of this subsection.
