- 2 **1.** Page 1, line 5: after "teams" insert ", providing an exemption from emergency rule procedures, granting rule–making authority".
 - **2.** Page 2, line 6: after that line insert:
- 4 "Section 2g. 166.20 (2) (bg) of the statutes is created to read:
- 5 166.20 (2) (bg) Promulgate rules establishing an amount not to exceed \$6,000 that may be an eligible cost for computers in an emergency planning grant under s.
- 7 166.21 (2) (bm).".

- **3.** Page 2, line 9: delete lines 9 and 10 and substitute: "emergency response equipment, but not to exceed \$10,000, of which not more than \$6,000 may be for computers. In-kind contributions may be used to meet the com-".
 - **4.** Page 2, line 11: substitute a plain period for the underscored period.
- **5.** Page 4, line 14: after that line insert:
- 11 "Section 10m. Nonstatutory provisions.

(1) Using the procedure under section 227.24 of the statutes, the state emergency response board shall promulgate rules required under section 166.20 (2) (bg) of the statutes, as created by this act, for the period before the effective date of the permanent rules promulgated under section 166.20 (2) (bg) of the statutes, as created by this act, but not to exceed the period authorized under section 227.24 (1) (c) and (2) of the statutes. Notwithstanding section 227.24 (1) and (3) of the statutes, the board need not provide evidence of the necessity of preservation of the public peace, health, safety or welfare in promulgating the rules under this subsection.".
