ASSEMBLY AMENDMENT 2, TO 1995 ASSEMBLY BILL 149

July 24, 1995 – Offered by Representative URBAN.

1	At the locations indicated, amend the bill as follows:
2	1. Page 1, line 2: delete the material beginning with "prohibiting" and ending
	with "employes" on line 4 and substitute: "residency requirements for certain
	employes of cities, villages, towns, counties and school districts".
3	2. Page 3, line 13: delete lines 13 and 14 and substitute:
4	"(2) In this section:
5	(a) "Key election" means a spring primary, a spring election, a September
6	primary or a general election.
7	(b) "Local governmental unit" means any city, village, town, county or school
8	district.".
9	3. Page 3, line 18: after "(4)" insert "(a)".
10	4. Page 3, line 20: after that line insert:
11	"(b) A local governmental unit may require, as a condition of employment, that
12	any employe or prospective employe reside within a jurisdictional limit if all of the
13	following occur:

1	1. The electors of the local governmental unit, in a referendum, approve an
2	ordinance enacted by or resolution adopted by the local governmental unit that
3	provides for a residency requirement for employes or prospective employes of the
4	local governmental unit.
5	2. The referendum described in subd. 1. occurs at a key election that is held
6	from 1992 to 1996.
7	(5) An ordinance or resolution that is approved in a referendum under sub. (4)
8	(b) may be repealed by the local governmental unit if an ordinance enacted by or
9	resolution adopted by the local governmental unit that repeals the residency
10	requirement is approved by the electors of the local governmental unit in a
11	referendum.".
12	5. Page 4, line 2: after that line insert:
13	"SECTION 7. Effective date.
14	(1) This act takes effect on January 1, 1997.".
