## ASSEMBLY AMENDMENT 2, TO 1995 ASSEMBLY BILL 211

November 14, 1995 - Offered by Representatives Rutrowski, Cullen and Kunicki.

At the locations indicated, amend the bill as follows:

1. Page 1 , line 8 : delete that line and substitute:
" 756.096 (3) (am) 1. A jury in misdemeanor cases shall consist of 6 persons if, before impaneling the 6 -person jury, the court makes a written finding with respect to the case being tried that the persons that have been summoned for jury service represent a fair cross section of the population of the area served by the court.
2. A jury in a misdemeanor case shall consist of 12 persons if the court does not make the findings specified in subd. 1.".
3. Page 2, line 7: after "case" insert "or in a misdemeanor case to which s. 756.096 (3) (am) 2. applies".
4. Page 2, line 10: after "case" insert "to which s. 756.096 (3) (am) 1. applies".
5. Page 2, line 21: after "cases" insert "or in misdemeanor cases to which s. 756.096 (3) (am) 2. applies,".
6. Page 2, line 22: after "cases" insert "to which s. 756.096 (3) (am) 1. applies". (END)
