



**ASSEMBLY AMENDMENT 5,  
TO ASSEMBLY SUBSTITUTE AMENDMENT 1,  
TO 1995 ASSEMBLY BILL 444**

December 7, 1995 - Offered by COMMITTEE ON CRIMINAL JUSTICE AND CORRECTIONS.

1 At the locations indicated, amend the substitute amendment as follows:

2 **1.** Page 2, line 3: after that line insert:

3 **"SECTION 3m.** Subchapter VI of chapter 111 [precedes 111.95] of the statutes is  
4 created to read:

5 **CHAPTER 111**

6 **SUBCHAPTER VI**

7 **COMPLAINTS CONCERNING EMPLOYMENT**

8 **OF COUNTY JAIL PRISONERS**

9 **111.95 Complaints concerning employment of county jail prisoners.**

10 Any person who believes that he or she has been adversely affected by a violation of  
11 s. 303.10 (4) may, within 30 days after the alleged violation occurs, file a complaint  
12 with the employment relations commission. The commission shall receive and  
13 process the complaints. If the commission determines, after investigation, that  
14 probable cause exists to believe a violation of s. 303.10 (4) has occurred, the

1 commission shall proceed with notice and a hearing on the complaint as provided in  
2 ch. 227.”.

3 **2.** Page 8, line 10: after the period insert: “Any person who believes that he or  
4 she has been adversely affected by a violation of this subsection may file a complaint  
5 with the employment relations commission as provided under s. 111.95.”.
