- 44.46 Historic agricultural building grant program. (1) In this section, "historic agricultural building" means any building or structure that is used primarily for agricultural purposes and which is significant in the history, architecture or culture of this state.
- (2) From the appropriation under s. 20.245 (3) (c), the historical society shall award grants to owners of historic agricultural buildings to provide assistance in the restoration of such buildings.
- (3) Grants shall be awarded in accordance with criteria approved by the state review baord under s. 44.33 (8). Subject to sub. (3), the historical society shall establish procedures and criteria for awarding grants under this section.
