9	SECTION 2. 20.245 (3) (c) of the statutes is created to read:
10	20.245 (3) (c) Historic agricultural building grant program. The amounts in
11	the schedule for the historic agricultural building grant program under s. 44.46.
12	SECTION 3. 44.33 (8) of the statutes is created to read:
13	44.33 (8) Review and approve criteria for awarding grants under s. 44.46.

SECTION 4. 44.46 of the statutes is created to read: 1 $\mathbf{2}$ 44.46 Historic agricultural building grant program. (1) In this section, 3 "historic agricultural building" means any building or structure that was 4 constructed primarily for agricultural purposes and which is significant in the $\mathbf{5}$ history, architecture or culture of this state. 6 (2) From the appropriation under s. 20.245 (3) (c), the historical society shall award grants to owners of historic agricultural buildings to provide assistance in the 7 8 restoration of such buildings. 9 (3) The historical society shall establish procedures and criteria for awarding grants under this section. The criteria shall be approved by the state review board 10 11 under s. 44.33 (8). 12(END)
