- (2) (a) Upon receipt of sufficient contributions from interested parties, including any county, city, village or town, to cover the cost of erecting a marker along a route specified in sub. (1) to clearly identify to motorists the designation of the route as the "Flyway Highway", the department shall erect and maintain the marker. No state funds, other than from the receipt of contributions under this subsection, may be expended for the erection or maintenance of the marker.
- (b) Notwithstanding par. (a), any county, city, village or town may erect and maintain a marker along a route specified in sub. (1) to clearly identify to motorists the designation of the route as the "Flyway Highway" if the highway is under the jurisdiction of the county, city, village or town.".
