



**ASSEMBLY AMENDMENT 14,
TO ASSEMBLY SUBSTITUTE AMENDMENT 1,
TO 1995 ASSEMBLY BILL 557**

October 3, 1995 - Offered by Representatives BALDUS, WILDER, BLACK, SPRINGER,
HUBER, WIRCH and KRUG.

1 At the locations indicated, amend the substitute amendment as follows:

2 **1.** Page 4, line 5: before "auditing" insert: "appointment of the secretary of
3 transportation;"

4 **2.** Page 4, line 8: before that line insert:

5 "SECTION 1c. 13.489 (1) of the statutes is amended to read:

6 13.489 (1) CREATION. There is created a transportation projects commission
7 consisting of the governor, 3 citizen members appointed by the governor to serve at
8 his or her pleasure, and 5 senators and 5 representatives to the assembly appointed
9 as are the members of standing committees in their respective houses. Of the
10 members from each house, 3 shall be chosen from the majority party and 2 shall be
11 chosen from the minority party. ~~The secretary of transportation shall serve as a~~
12 ~~nonvoting member.~~ The governor shall serve as chairperson. Citizen members of the
13 commission shall be reimbursed for their actual and necessary expenses incurred as
14 members of the commission from the appropriation under s. 20.395 (4) (aq).
