At the locations indicated, amend the substitute amendment as follows:

- **1.** Page 4, line 19: increase the dollar amount for fiscal year 1995–96 by \$3,812,200 and increase the dollar amount for fiscal year 1996–97 by \$9,061,900 to increase funding for the purpose for which the appropriation is made.
 - **2.** Page 5, line 4: delete lines 4 and 5.
 - **3.** Page 14, line 9: after that line insert:
- 7 "Section 6m. 20.395 (1) (bu) of the statutes is repealed.".
 - **4.** Page 31, line 3: after that line insert:
- 9 "Section 62m. 85.20 (4m) (a) of the statutes is amended to read:
 - 85.20 (4m) (a) From the amounts appropriated under s. 20.395 (1) (bq), an amount equal to 47.5% or, for urban mass transit systems operating within an urban area having a population of less than 50,000 as shown in the 1990 federal decennial census, 42% of the projected operating expenses of each eligible applicant's urban mass transit system shall be allocated to each eligible applicant.
