1 At the locations indicated, amend the substitute amendment as follows:

- **1.** Page 4, line 19: increase the dollar amount for fiscal year 1995–96 by \$2,613,900 and increase the dollar amount for fiscal year 1996–97 by \$3,495,500 to increase funding for the purpose for which the appropriation is made.
 - **2.** Page 31, line 3: after that line insert:
- "Section 67m. 85.20 (4m) (a) of the statutes is amended to read:
 - 85.20 **(4m)** (a) From the amounts appropriated under s. 20.395 (1) (bq), an amount equal to 42% 44% of the projected operating expenses of each eligible applicant's urban mass transit system shall be allocated to each eligible applicant.
 - **Section 67r.** 85.20 (4m) (em) 1. of the statutes is amended to read:
- 11 85.20 **(4m)** (em) 1. An amount equal to 42% 44% of the audited operating expenses for the project year of the applicant's urban mass transit system.".
