



**ASSEMBLY AMENDMENT 21,
TO ASSEMBLY SUBSTITUTE AMENDMENT 2,
TO 1995 ASSEMBLY BILL 557**

October 12, 1995 - Offered by Representative LORGE.

1 At the locations indicated, amend the substitute amendment as follows:

2 **1.** Page 3, line 13: after the semicolon insert "use of social security numbers;"

3 **2.** Page 47, line 14: after that line insert:

4 "SECTION 143g. 343.022 of the statutes is created to read:

5 **343.022 Use of social security numbers.** (1) Except as provided in s. 343.14
6 (2) (bm), the department may not require an individual, for the purposes of chs. 340
7 to 349 and 351, to disclose his or her social security number, but may request an
8 individual to disclose his or her social security number to assist the department in
9 accessing his or her records if the department informs the individual that he or she
10 may refuse to disclose the number.

11 **(2)** The department may not disclose any social security number collected
12 under chs. 340 to 349 and 351. This subsection does not apply to the disclosure of
13 a social security number to a law enforcement agency, as defined in s. 165.83 (1) (b),
14 a federal governmental agency or an agency of this state, to perform a legally
15 authorized function. Any law enforcement agency, federal governmental agency or

1 agency of this state that obtains a social security number from the department may
2 not disclose that number except to perform a legally authorized function.”.

3 **3.** Page 52, line 25: after that line insert:

4 “**SECTION 162g.** 343.14 (2) (b) of the statutes is amended to read:

5 343.14 (2) (b) The applicant’s date of birth, ~~social security number~~, color of eyes,
6 color of hair, sex, height, weight and race;

7 **SECTION 162m.** 343.14 (2) (bm) of the statutes is created to read:

8 343.14 (2) (bm) A space for the applicant to provide his or her social security
9 number, together with a prominent statement informing the applicant that he or she
10 is not required to disclose the number in order to obtain a license unless he or she
11 is applying for a commercial driver license;”.
