



**ASSEMBLY AMENDMENT 11,
TO 1995 ASSEMBLY BILL 6**

January 17, 1995 – Offered by Representatives TURNER, HANSON, BLACK, PLOMBON,
ROBSON, MORRIS-TATUM, GROBSCHMIDT, CARPENTER and L. YOUNG.

1 At the locations indicated, amend the bill as follows:

2 **1.** Page 1, line 6: after that line insert:

3 “**SECTION 2.** 121.91 (4) (d) of the statutes is created to read:

4 121.91 (4) (d) The limit otherwise applicable to a school district’s revenue under
5 sub. (2m) in any school year is increased by an amount equal to the amount spent by
6 the school district in that school year for security measures designed to prevent
7 criminal activity in schools, as determined by the state superintendent.

8 **SECTION 3. Initial applicability.**

9 (1) This act first applies to the calculation of a school district’s revenue limit
10 in the 1995–96 school year.”.
