



**ASSEMBLY AMENDMENT 14,
TO 1995 ASSEMBLY BILL 69**

October 2, 1995 – Offered by Representative RILEY.

1 At the locations indicated, amend the bill as follows:

2 **1.** Page 2, line 6: delete lines 6 to 19 and substitute:

3 “(4) (a) Nothing in this section prohibits a political subdivision from continuing
4 to enforce an ordinance or resolution that regulates the sale, purchase, purchase
5 delay, transfer, ownership, use, keeping, possession, bearing, transportation,
6 licensing, permitting, registration or taxation of any firearm if the ordinance or
7 resolution is in effect on May 1, 1995.

8 (b) A political subdivision may enact an ordinance or adopt a resolution after
9 the effective date of this paragraph [revisor inserts date], that regulates the sale,
10 purchase, purchase delay, transfer, ownership, use, keeping, possession, bearing,
11 transportation, licensing, permitting, registration or taxation of any firearm, and
12 that is not the same as or similar to a state statute if the ordinance or resolution is
13 approved in a referendum that is held in the political subdivision.”.
